Installing Carbon Signature












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Importing Package

Once you installed **Sage XRT Business Exchange**, you can keep the previous version of **Signature** or upgrade to the new Carbon **Signature**:

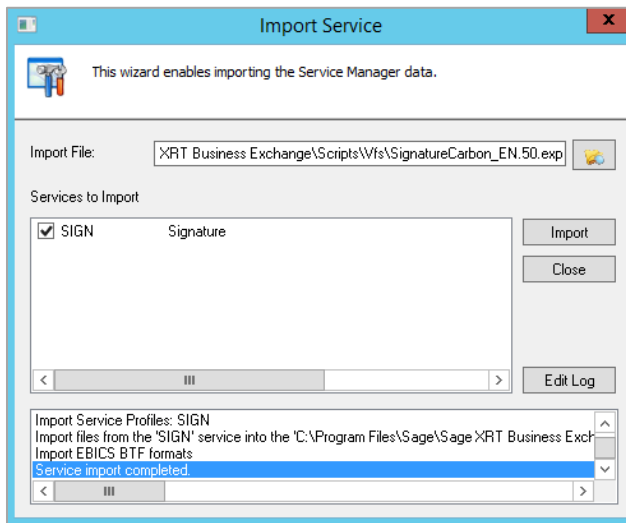
- If you want to keep the previous version of **Signature**, import *Signature.pck* which is installed by **Sage XRT Business Exchange** by default. You can find it in *C:\Program Files\Sage\Sage XRT Business Exchange\Scripts\Vfs*.
- If you choose to use the new Carbon **Signature**, go to *Sharepoint* to access the packages by language: *SignatureCarbon_EN.50.exp*, *SignatureCarbon_ES.50.exp* and *SignatureCarbon_FR.50.exp*.

Importing Package

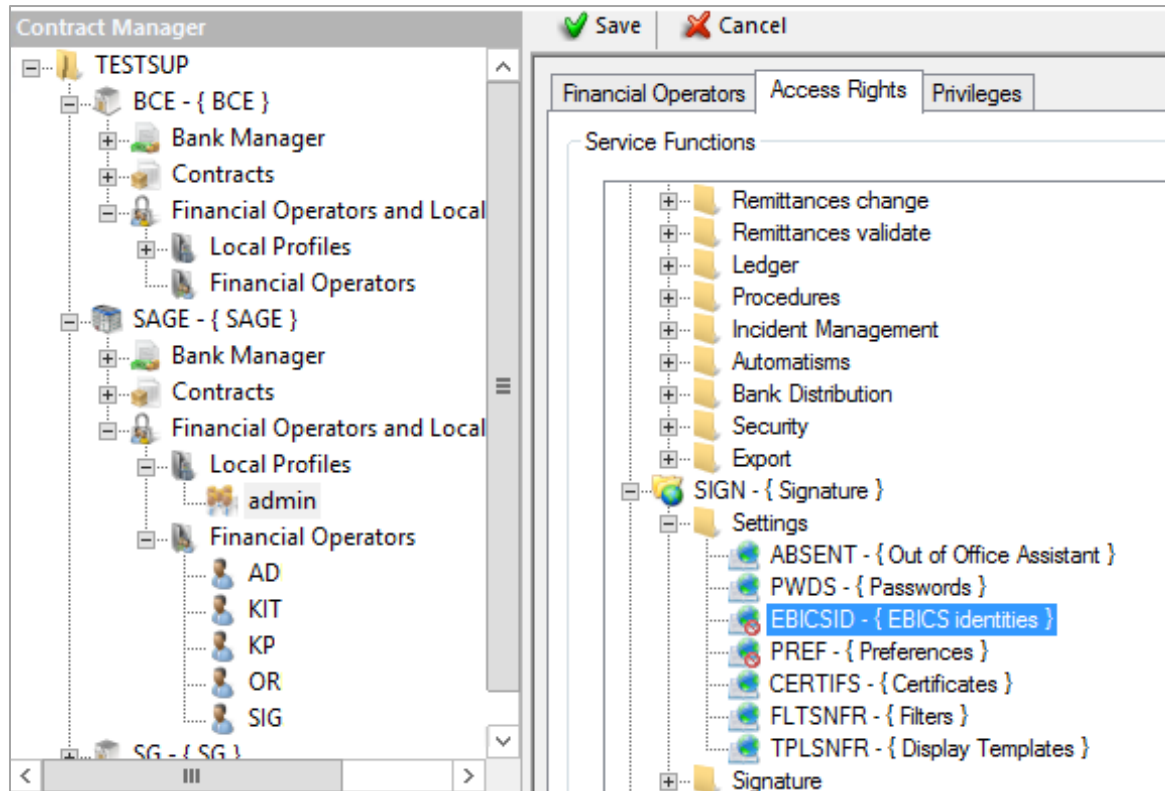
Eventually, import it through the **Service Manager**.



You may revert to the previous version of **Signature** by re-importing *Signature.pck*, or, if you kept the previous version, upgrade later to the new one by importing the Carbon **Signature** package.

Access Rights

For the local profile of each entity in the **Service Manager**, you must grant access to both sub-menus **EBICS Identities** and **General Preferences**.



Access through OnlineBanking

Log in **OnlineBanking** and go to the **Signature** module.



In the **Setup** dropdown menu, make sure you can see both sub-menus **EBICS Identities** and **General Preferences**.
